Lastly, I want to express my gratitude to our member clubs. Your players, committees, club members, volunteers, and supporters form the foundation of the RDCA. Without your dedication and passion, we would not be where we are today.

Now, let's review the season in detail.

On the field,

Season 22/23 presented us with challenges and delays due to heavy rain in October. Despite these obstacles, our committees worked tirelessly to ensure that play could happen whenever possible. Their extraordinary efforts to revise fixtures and formats throughout the season ensured the best outcomes for all competitions.

The performance of each of our competitions remained incredibly strong, with our Juniors and Senior Men's competitions seeing consolidated numbers.

Our veteran's competition took a new path by combining with a new outer east pathway, resulting in several premierships for the RDCA.

Our women's competition also made great progress in growing our female participation base, establishing the RDCA's Women's Outer East competition as the envy of every other association in Victoria.

Off the field,

Season 22/23 was a year of succession and learning, particularly in our senior committee. We saw several long-term committee members step aside, and I want to extend a huge thank you to them for their years of service. Their contributions have made the RDCA richer.

The new look senior committee lead by David Peel and Paul Broussard faced some short-term challenges during the transition, compounded by the late start to the season. However, they performed outstandingly well in testing times. Their new thinking and evolved T-20 competition were a resounding success.

Of particular note was tireless and outstanding work behind scenes from Adam Kuklych whose efforts to ensure all MyCricket admin and updates were delivered on time in a highly fluid and everchanging cricket landscape for the first 6 weeks were immense.

Our women's outer east committee, in its second year, continued to develop and progress, delivering two years of community women's cricket. Their exceptional work has established the RDCA's women's competition as the leading community women's competition in Victoria.

In Summary

In the season, that proved to be unique in many aspects from start to finish, the RDCA was able to deliver a highly successful outcome across all grades and all competitions.

Culminating in the RDCA being recognised in the following manner.

1. Cricket Victoria - Community Cricket Association of the year Season 22/23
2. 2023 Deakin Community Awards – RDCA Award winner for contribution to supporting local communities in Deakin through sport.

Looking ahead,

The board of management has been working extensively in the off-season to achieve two key outcomes:

- A revised and updated constitution and
- A renewed strategic plan.

With the RDCA's exponential growth and evolution, it was crucial to revise these documents to ensure we continue to deliver an outstanding competition that fosters growth across all aspects and safeguards our long-term success.

We will provide a framework where clubs and their local communities can participate in a strong, well-run, secure, and vibrant competition. Our goal is to meet both club and community expectations, allowing everyone to be a part of writing their own unique cricket story.

The revision process involved significant consultation with all clubs and stakeholders, including player and leadership surveys, direct contact with clubs, and face-to-face sessions.

We have identified several areas of focus, including increased communication frameworks, increasing umpire numbers, assessing competition formats for maximum participation and retention, supporting and including every aspect of our local community, and working closely with clubs to ensure their success.

At an operational level,

We will continue to ensure the success of every competition and its format.

The implementation of PlayHQ to replace MyCricket is right now one of our strongest focus points and in the short term it will require some adjustments, but we are extremely confident in its long-term potential.

We will also explore new ways for clubs to increase participation in an inclusive manner, strengthen communication lines, and ensure ease of interaction with the RDCA structure.

Finance Manager - Graeme Seymour

Season 2022/23 commenced on time on 1st October without the full spectre of COVID protocols hanging over us per the previous 2 seasons. Then the rains came to wash out a couple of rounds in late October. But after that, cricket resumed pretty much "as normal" for the rest of the season.

On the financial front, the RDCA has completed another successful season with Gross Turnover (excluding Umpire Match Day fees where we only act as a collection facility) increasing from \$351,575 in 2022 season to \$362,071 in 2023. Major revenue increases were Ball Sales \$180,931 (2022 \$165,816), the re-introduction of the various T20 Competitions \$8,455 (2022 \$Nil), End of year Presentation night revenues \$15,836 (2022 \$11,873). There were some reductions in revenue items namely, Sponsorships reduced to \$58,794 (2022 \$61,959), Grants, both Government & Cricket Victoria \$5,000 (2022 \$12,250).

Our expenses increased from \$331,484 in 2022 to \$347,202 in the 2023 season. The major changes being Ball purchases \$174,603 (2022 \$160,284), T20 Competition prize monies \$8,000 (2022 \$Nil), Presentation night costs \$23,909 (2022 \$21,442), Clothing costs \$13,882 (2022 \$11,697), Club Welfare payments \$2,000 (2022 \$Nil)

The Association finished the season with a surplus of \$14,799 compared to last season's surplus of \$18,801. This was slightly below budgeted expectations, but under the circumstances was a satisfactory result.

At seasons end we have cash reserves of \$150,605 (2022 \$130,196) including \$35,403 in the RDCA/YVCA Transition account being used for ongoing support of the former YVCA Clubs under the terms of the Transition Agreement.

In closing I would like to thank all the Association's sponsors for their continuing support. Without them and the numerous Association & Club volunteers, the RDCA would not be the preeminent Metropolitan Cricket Association that it is today. On a personal level, I would also like to thank all Club Treasurers for their co-operation during the season.

VMCU - Pat Meehan

The VMCU consists of a Board made up of the 8 Directors of each Metropolitan Region, together with delegates from every Metropolitan Cricket Association. Pat Meehan is both the Director – Outer East on the Board and the RDCA Delegate.

Over the past season the main cricket activities have related to the management and implementation of metropolitan cricket. Again, this season the representative matches associated with CV State – wide T20 competition and the VMCU U/21 Neil Wright Shield were not held; however, the VMCU Junior Carnival proceeded in January 2023. This junior competition comprised of 106 teams, including 34 girls teams, with about 1,300 players from 12 Association. The RDCA was strongly represented with 10 teams entered in all grades. Success came with a premiership in the U/14 Allen Shield, runners up in the U/17 Jones Shield with another three teams competing in the semi-finals – U/16 Beitzel Shield, U/16 Mackay Shield and U/12 Mitchell Shield. Huge thanks are extended to all players, coaches, managers, parents, and umpires for their significant contribution to this successful Carnival.

The most significant matters dealt with during the season were:

- Implementation of Australian Cricket's Child Safety Framework by all Associations and clubs to meet the updated Victorian Child Safe Standards, especially the appointment of Child Safety Officers at all clubs state-wide. Clubs need to formally minute the adoption of the "Safeguarding Children Policy" to CV before the commencement of season 2023/2024. Monitoring the progress of the implementation within each Association is ongoing.
- Continuing negotiations with CA/CV on MyCricket issues and the new replacement platform (PlayHQ) which is being developed by CA contractors with staged implementation and trials of modules. Briefings on progress and the coverage of the components was provided by the CV Manager and relevant staff to VMCU Board and Delegates during the season. The introduction of this new platform for Metropolitan Associations is scheduled for season 2023/2024. CV staff have been progressively rolling out the package with workshops and sessions with Associations and their clubs since February 2023. Fees have been set by CA/CV for insurance, player registration and administration. All players senior and junior both male and female must register online through PlayHQ before they can play next season. The VMCU Board is monitoring the implementation progress with CV Management. A small group of RDCA'S Committees representatives is working towards this implementation with its clubs.
- Whilst there will be no U/21 Neil Wright Shield for the foreseeable future, discussions are current with the VCCL on continuing the annual match with the VMCU, including appropriate age group and format. The aim would be to play such a match in early February each year.
- Regular updates have been held with CV staff on organisational changes, cricket participation statistics, schools and cricket blast programs, available cricket grants to clubs and associations, the interaction with Youth Premier League, Premier Cricket and the VMCU Junior Carnival and CV annual strategic plans for next season. A new CV Premier Pathway Strategy, incorporating U/15, U/16 and U/18 female and male groups, has been developed during the current season to replace the existing Youth Premier League. This document has now been recently adopted by Premier Cricket clubs who will be responsible for the

implementation phase. No mention is made of the role played by the VMCU Junior Carnival or Associations in the development of junior cricket and representative opportunities.

- Extensive discussions held by the Board and Delegates on the loss of umpires in most associations due to Covid and player behavioural issues (loss of respect for umpires decisions), recruitment of new umpires and the need for CV to develop a marketing program going forward. New CV umpiring staff have commenced on these tasks in conjunction with the recently formed VMCU Umpire Advisors Group, comprising of an umpire representative of each metropolitan association, which will meet regularly to progress and resolve the identified issues.
- Following the identification of the loss of association volunteers and the difficulty in finding replacements, the Board suggested to CV Management that paid replacement administrators appeared to be the best option for the near future. A couple of Associations initiated this option for this season using either their own funding or levying clubs. Some success has been reported. CV staff investigated possible funding options (without specific CV funding) and have recently presented 4 options for associations to choose from. These will be the subject of ongoing considerations by both the VMCU Board and all Associations. As a prelude some RDCA investigations with other associations on possible options and funding methods was undertaken late last year to determine the RDCA position to ultimately put to all clubs.

In addition, the VMCU is also the body which deals with both club and player appeals against penalties imposed by an Association, which if it meets the criteria, would be considered by its independent panel for final resolution.

Outer East Metro - Pat Meehan

The Outer East Region covers the municipalities of Knox, Maroondah and Yarra Ranges and comprises of clubs in the Ringwood and District Cricket Association (VMCU Affiliate) and the Ferntree Gully Cricket Association (VCCL Affiliate). The former Yarra Valley Cricket Association clubs have now been fully integrated within the RDCA Senior and Junior grades following a smooth and successful transition over the last two seasons. Some former YVCA clubs have merged. The RDCA received significant recognition by being named at the "Cricket Association of the Year" in Cricket Victoria's Community Cricket Awards for season 2022/23. Our congratulations are extended to all involved. This season the RDCA had 58 clubs with 152 senior teams, 250 junior teams (male and female), 24 women's teams and 35 veterans teams with 4,800 overall participants. Premier Cricket is represented in the region by Ringwood Cricket Club with the Victorian Sub-District Cricket Association represented by both Bayswater and Croydon Cricket Clubs.

C V staff operating in the region for the season were Clinton Kennon, Area Manager and Stephen Box, Cricket Manager- Outer East Metro. These people assisted all clubs and work closely with them and schools in the region to offer a program of clinics, competitions, and activities to increase the availability of cricket in various formats to both male and female participants.

Ringwood C.C. is our partner for the regional pathway program and assists in the management and coaching of the Outer East Eagles male and female squads in the State

Championships. The Annual RCC v RDCA match was played at Jubilee Park, main oval, on Wednesday 15th February 2023, with the RCC winning by two runs in the last over.

The region was strongly represented in the VMCU Junior Carnival held in January 2023 as the RDCA entered 10 male and female teams in all grades and FTGDCA entered 7 teams (6 male and 1 female). RDCA were the premiers in the U/14 Allen Shield and runners up in the U/17 Jones Shield with another three teams competing in the semi-finals in U/16 Beitzel Shield, U/16 Mackay Shield and U/12 Mitchell Shield. The FTGDCA were premiers in the U/18 Arnold Shield and runners up in the U/16 Mackay Shield. Huge thanks are extended to all players, parents, players, managers, coaches, and umpires for their significant contribution to this successful Carnival.

Women's cricket continues to grow within the region both at Premier Cricket level with RCC and the Associations. The RDCA girls competition had 33 teams in 5 grades. The standard is also improving as evidenced with some Stage 3 girls players making their debuts in women's teams. The RDCA managed the "RDCA Women's East" competition again this season to provide a pathway for allow all women and junior girls in both the Outer and Inner East Regions to participate in cricket at all skill levels. This resulted in 20 clubs entering 24 women's teams in 3 grades including 16 teams from RDCA and 3 teams from FTGDCA. FTGDCA conducted a small social sixes competition with 5 teams competing, including 3 teams who played in the Women's East competition last season. Many of these were new teams included women who have never played cricket before and Stage 3 girls. This was once again highly successful with many other clubs from both Associations indicating that they hope to enter teams in this competition next season.

Wet weather and ground conditions delayed the start for the majority of grades until late October / early November. The top grades played a mix of two day and one day matches with the lower grades playing all one day matches, including finals. Thankfully, the season and all finals were successfully completed with minimal impact on team numbers. Let us hope that the 2023/2024 season can commence on the first Saturday in October 2022 with a return to our normal fixture of two day and one day matches being implemented.

We had a season that was not interrupted by Covid, but a very wet October presented plenty of challenges for the cricketing community. We were able to resume playing 2 day cricket which saw some brilliant individual performances and the standard of cricket was as high as I can remember.

The great thing about our junior competition is how many clubs are actively running strong junior programs. Having a large number of teams, means we can place them in the right grade, which then provides exciting and close games of cricket. We thank the BHRDCA for entering teams in our Saturday morning competition and we reciprocate with RDCA clubs playing in the BHRDCA on Friday nights. Providing our young players the opportunity to play games at their appropriate skill level is a huge focus for us.

The RDCA girls competition has consolidated its position in the cricketing landscape and had 33 teams, across 3 age groups and 5 divisions. These girls will be the driving force behind strengthening our senior RDCA female competition. We want to provide the opportunity for our most talented players to move onto premier cricket whilst still providing playing opportunities at local levels. The stage 3 Mandy Dolman Shield saw Norwood complete a great season with a convincing win over Warranwood.

Overall there were 24 divisions of cricket playing for premierships and we had 18 different clubs win premierships. This shows that our clubs are creating enjoyable environments for our junior cricketers to flourish. North Ringwood completed a remarkable trifecta winning the 12/1, 14/1 and 16/1 premierships. Warranwood won our Junior Club Championship and this was a deserving reward for years of hard work by the players, coaches and volunteers. Congratulations to all the Sharks who helped their club earn enough points to win this award.

Our competition runs smoothly due to the hard work of our clubs. But there is a passionate group of people who are on the junior committee that ensure everything works. Bill Stafford is our Junior secretary and the main contact point for our junior co-ordinators. He is always ready to help clubs and ensure they can run good junior programs. He is a tremendous problem solver who is always thinking about what is best for our young players. As well as helping our clubs, he brings together our Representative Program.

We have developed a strong umpiring community over the last few seasons and we have Doug Dowling to thank for this. Recruiting umpires in any sport is a challenge and we have been able to grow our numbers, which often provides young people an opportunity to continue their participation in cricket.

We thank Luke Henderson from South Croydon, Sean Meehan from Templeton and Steve Toohey from Warranwood who all provide valuable insight into junior sport and help us make good decisions.

Paul Attfield and Scott Brasher continue with their amazing support of cricket and the RDCA. Having access to Saxon Sports and their great indoor facility is vital for the continued growth and improvement of our young players.

Junior Secretary - Bill Stafford

Following 3 years of COVID we looked forward to a more normal season. Whilst COVID was still present in the community it did not impact the playing season. This season we had to contend with a very wet spring causing local flooding, resulting in a high number of grounds being unplayable during October and November.

Two complete rounds were abandoned and some games in other rounds could not be played due to grounds being unplayable. Some clubs who were severely impacted by the conditions of grounds, worked tirelessly in finding alternate grounds or arranging games to be rescheduled during the week.

This season we ended up with 251 teams, which is a similar number to last season. In the girls we attempted to introduce a hard ball into Stage 1 Stars. However, clubs did not think their players were ready for this level of cricket, so we went with 2 grades of Stage 1 Spirit with both grades being non-competitive.

In the top 3 grades in U/12s and all U/14 and U/16 grades we were able to schedule a mixture of one day and two day games. In our top 3 U/16 grades, batters can score 100 before retiring, we had 21 centuries.

Congratulations to Warranwood on winning the Club Champion. After a number of years finishing in the top 3 they had a great season to win the award. Special mention also goes to North Ringwood on winning the top 3 boys grand finals – 12/1, 14/1 and 16/1.

Once again, this season with the support of Cricket Victoria (provided 50% of funding), we run a Coach the Coaches Program. Dale Ingleton was re-appointed Director of Coaching. 15 clubs joined the program by appointing a lead coach to attend master classes run by Dale and CV. Also, during the season Dale visited a number of clubs to either run training sessions or observe and provide feedback.

This season we extended paid umpires to cover grades U16/1 to 3, U14/1 to 3, U12/1 to 3 and Girls Stage 3.

Once again, we joined forces with Saxon Sports and with Mukti Australia (a Christian organisation for disadvantage woman and children) in sending cricket gear to Sri Lanka. Clubs and families supported us in dropping off second hand junior cricket equipment and clothing to Saxon Sports. Also, SEDA donated 5 full bags of plastic cricket equipment. In all there was just under 200 Kg of equipment shipped over to Sri Lanka. The Board of Management contributed \$500 to pay for the cost of shipping.








Planning is already underway for season 2023-24 where we expect to expand our competition at entry level and welcome new clubs to our RDCA Women's East family


