The season that was

The merger of the YVCA into the RDCA was a process that was over 8 months in the making.

Lots of painstaking work was done in the background to ensure all the YVCA clubs and their history is acknowledged and preserved.

We are very determined to ensure a new chapter in the valley for all cricket communities can now be written.

I would like to pay tribute to the committee of the YVCA for their vision, foresight and courage to take the steps that whilst hard, were necessary to progress forward.

To YVCA President David Peel and Vice President Paul Broussard a very large thank you for all your hard work.

In our Senior and Junior grades we welcomed the Yarra Valley Cricket Association into our fold which proved to be a great success.

Our Senior competition expanded with the addition of the clubs from the Yarra Valley into not only the RDCA main draw but also forming several Valley Region grades to ensure all clubs could participate on their best level appropriately.

The RDCA Juniors go from strength to strength. 250 teams, over 27 different divisions with 21 different premiers. All age grades experienced strong growth. In particular a great result for our girls competition growing from 23-31 teams.

The RDCA Veterans comp whilst having a delayed start finished strongly. Both Masters Grades had full seasons and the Vets T20 Big Bash continues to grow from strength to strength.

For more detailed updates on each of the competitions please refer to respective reports given.

Finally, as many would have seen, the RDCA is the first local association to be awarded the rights from Cricket Victoria to run the Women's senior competition taking over in the East from the WCCC.

Another major win for the RDCA and local Women's cricket with clear pathways now being set in motion from Blasters to Juniors now through to Seniors for all RDCA female players.

Looking forward into season 21/22

The upcoming season sees us filled with great enthusiasm and optimism and yet again the RDCA for the second year in a row will further expand in size and scope.

As a Board of Management our focus will be to ensure we continually revise and refine our strategic plans and then execute them effectively with the learnings of last season across all areas.

Key drivers for our planning are Growth, Integration and Financial Astuteness across all RDCA verticals.

To continue to communicate all relevant messages effectively to our clubs.

To remain vigilant on what Covid may still have in store for us

To focus on growing participation rates in all areas, in particular our Girls and new Women's competition.

The establishment of a new Senior Women's committee to oversee the new women's comp.

To further refine and integrate the senior Men's competition with our new Valley clubs into the RDCA main draw.

Above all else, to ensure the RDCA remains the premier community cricket competition in Victoria serving now every member and every gender in all of it's many local communities.

Finance Manager - Graeme Seymour

Season 2020/21 was a very "different" season for the RDCA. COVID19 delayed our season start, forced us to introduce a season of all one-day games, cancelled one round mid-season, required the Association to pay all Umpires via EFT and of course was the first year of the amalgamation with the former Yarra Valley Cricket Association ("YVCA") which considerably expanded the whole Association Club & Team numbers.

Notwithstanding all the above, the season was a financial success. Although we have reported a small financial loss for the year of \$1,287 (2020 \$6,122 surplus), included in this loss were some expenses directly attributable to season 2019/20. Because there were no Presentation Nights held in 2019/20, all Junior & Senior Trophies were not purchased until August 2020. This cost was \$5,371.

Excluding Umpire match day fees collected & paid on behalf of Clubs & Umpires which is just a "contra" exercise, the RDCA's revenues increased from \$242,240 (2020) to \$308,756. This increase can be largely attributed to the expanded competition post the YVCA amalgamation. Affiliation fees increased from \$44,514 to \$56,718, Ball Sales increased from \$118,777 to \$153,043. In addition, the RDCA received Government COVID Grants of \$8,000 plus a Grant from Cricket Victoria of \$5,500.

Association Expenditure increased from \$236,118 in 2020 to \$310,283 for season 2021. The major increases being Ball Costs which increased from \$113,925 to \$142,488, previous seasons Trophy costs referred to above of \$5,371, cost of implementing the 1BreadCrumb App for COVID compliance requirements \$13,860. Other expenses increased commensurately with the increased size of the Association post the YVCA amalgamation.

At season end the Association is in an extremely strong financial position with cash on hand of \$163,472 (2020 \$74,222). Included in this cash reserve is \$86,058 being the current balance of the funds transferred from the YVCA on amalgamation. These funds have been

earmarked for the ongoing support of the former YVCA Clubs in accordance with the Transition Agreement signed between the RDCA & the YVCA.

I would like to thank all Club Treasurers for their cooperation during the season and all Association financial sponsors (as mentioned elsewhere in the Annual Report) for their continuing support. Without these sponsors, the RDCA would not be the pre-eminent suburban Cricket association its is today.

VMCU - Pat Meehan

Pat Meehan continued to represent the RDCA as our delegate to this body.

The VMCU consists of a Board made up of the 8 Directors of each Metropolitan Region, together with delegates from every Metropolitan Cricket Association. Pat Meehan is both the Director – Outer East on the Board and the RDCA Delegate.

Over the past season the main cricket activities have related to the management and implementation of metropolitan cricket and the impacts of Covid-19 which delayed the commencement of the season to mid-November 2020. The latter meant that this season the representative matches associated with CV State – wide T20 competition and the VMCU U/21 Neil Wright Shield were not held; however, the VMCU Junior Carnival proceeded in January 2021.

This junior competition comprised of 106 teams, including 33 girls teams, with about 1,300 players from 12 Associations – reduced from last season as the Mornington Peninsula Cricket and West Gippsland Cricket Associations did not enter teams due to the impacts of Covid-19 on team selections process.

The RDCA was strongly represented with 14 teams entered in all grades, including three extra teams in the second grades of boys U/12, U/14 and U/16 to cater for the increased number of players following the merger with the YVCA. Success came with premierships in the U/14 Allen Shield, U/16 Mackay Shield and U/16 Jones Shield (our first girls premiership) with another four teams competing in the semi-finals – U12 Fatone Shield (girls), U/14 Nolan Shield, U/16 Beitzel Shield and U/18 Arnold Shield (girls). An outstanding success which everyone in the RDCA can be proud of. Congratulations to all the players, coaches, team managers, administrators and parents for their hard work associated with all teams in the Carnival to achieve the best result ever for the RDCA.

The most significant matters dealt with during the season were:

- Negotiations with CV staff for 2020/21 cricket season and assessment of options for a delayed start due to Covid-19 lockdowns. Most Associations commenced on Saturday 14th November 2020 and fixtured 14 No. one day matches with finals. Discussions were also held on possible funding assistance to Associations and clubs for loss of sponsorship and other sources of income. As a result, some State Government, Cricket Australia and Cricket Victoria grants were received. Some councils either waived their annual rental charges or provided a reduction to clubs.
- Extensive discussions with CV on both male and female participation statistics with particular emphasis on junior boys and girls cricket, together with the transition from school programs to club cricket.
- VMCU discussions and input to CV Pathway Program, Youth Premier League (which was not held due to financial and Covid-19 impacts) and Premier Cricket proposals for all relevant age groups for both male and female championships. The VMCU Junior Carnival is part of the junior pathway structure.

- Identification of Member Protection Policy issues, being experienced in the implementation by Associations and clubs, to be considered as part of the current CV review and update of the policy. Urgent resolution of these issues was requested with a view to creating a new readable document.
- Implementation of Australian Cricket's Child Safety Framework by all Associations and clubs to meet the Victorian Child Safe Standards, especially the appointment of Child Safety Officers at all clubs state-wide. Clubs need to formally minute acceptance of the process to CV before the commencement of next season.
- Continuing negotiations with CA/CV on MyCricket issues being experienced by Associations and clubs, particularly with live scoring, team entries for matches and results administration. A replacement platform – PlayHQ – is being developed by CA contractors with staged implementation and trials of modules prior to implementation in 2022/2023. Trials of completed modules via Webinars are being produced every 3-4 months to provide progress on updates and seeking feedback, etc.
- Reviewed progress on the possible restructure of all cricket as set out in CV's Metropolitan Cricket Strategy. As with some Associations, due to the reduction of CV funding and regional staff, the RDCA formally withdrew in June 2020 from the process on the proposed Cricket East Metro. In addition, our key pillars / deliverables were not being met with the models under consideration.
- Undertaking a review of the U/21 Neil Wright Shield format as only a few Associations have competed in recent seasons. The competition was not held this season due to the impacts of Covid-19 on Associations.

In addition, the VMCU is also the body which deals with both club and player appeals against penalties imposed by an Association, which if it meets the criteria, would be considered by its independent panel for final resolution.

Outer East Metro - Pat Meehan

The Outer East Region covers the municipalities of Knox, Maroondah and Yarra Ranges and comprises of clubs in the Ringwood and District Cricket Association (VMCU Affiliate) and the Ferntree Gully Cricket Association (VCCL Affiliate). The Yarra Valley Cricket Association merged with the RDCA in mid-2020 to comprise of 40 clubs (just before the start of the season two clubs – Gruyere and Warburton amalgamated with Seville CC. A smooth and successful transition and integration of the Senior, Junior and Umpires Sections was achieved. Premier Cricket is represented in the region by Ringwood Cricket Club with the Victorian Sub-District Cricket Association represented by both Bayswater and Croydon Cricket Clubs.

C V staff operating in the region for the season were Clinton Kennon, Area Manager; Stephen Box, Cricket Manager and Sharon Lynas, Club Officer. These people assisted all clubs and worked closely with them and schools in the region to offer a program of clinics, competitions and activities to increase the availability of cricket in various formats to both male and female participants.

Ringwood C.C. is our partner for the regional pathway program and assists in the management and coaching of the Outer East Eagles male and female squads in the Youth Premier League (which was not held this season due to financial and Covid reasons). In addition, the club has established an Annual Outer East T20 Challenge Trophy competition between the Associations. This was also not held due to the late start of the season and T20 competitions. The Annual RCC v RDCA match was played at Jubilee Park, main oval, on Wednesday 24th February 2021, with the RCC winning by 12 runs.

The region was strongly represented in the VMCU Junior Carnival held in January 2021 as the RDCA entered 14 teams in all grades (with three extra teams in the second grades of boys U/12, U/14 and U/16 to cater for the increased number of players following the merger with YVCA) and FTGDCA entered 9 teams plus a combined U/18 girls team with ECA. RDCA were the premiers in the U/14 Allen Shield, U/16 Mackay Shield and U/16 Jones Shield with another 4 teams competing in the semi-finals – U/12 Fatone Shield, U/14 Nolan Shield, U/16 Beitzel Shield and U/18 Arnold Shield. The combined FTGDCA/ECA U/18 Fitzpatrick Shield was the only FTGDCA finalist team. Congratulations to all concerned with these teams. Overall an excellent performance by the RDCA – their best ever in this competition.

Women's cricket continues to grow within the region both at Premier Cricket level with RCC and the Associations. The RDCA girls competition grew again this season with 29 teams in 5 grades compared to 3 grades and 23 teams in the previous season. The standard is also improving evidenced with their U/16 Jones team winning their first girls premiership in the above Carnival. The RDCA Board is considering the possibility of introducing a women's senior grade in the future to provide a club pathway for all junior girls in the region.

With the reduction in CV funding and regional staff, the RDCA formally withdrew from the investigation of the proposed Cricket East Metro between ECA, BHRDCA and RDCA. However discussions are current on a number of mutual aspects to the three Associations such as umpires management, tribunals and junior cricket. Some initiatives arising are being implemented by individual Associations.

SENIOR COMMITTEE REPORTS

Secretary - Stuart Minetti

“This too shall pass.” COVID-19 pandemic.

In signing off the annual report for last season I mentioned that the worst of the COVID-19 pandemic seemed to be over and so it was, but it continued to significantly impact our season and continues to impact our lives as we approach next season. As season 2020/21 approached Victoria was still in a Stage 4 lockdown with diminishing prospects of a cricket season happening. All winter local sport had been completely cancelled. At the RDCA AGM Yarra Valley Cricket Association’s application to amalgamate with the RDCA was approved and so there was much work to do to enable a smooth transition for originally 12 and finally (with a double club merger) 10 new clubs joining our ranks.

The structure of our Senior Committee took on significant change with 2 representatives from Yarra Valley CA and four new members recruited by our President.

In today’s busy world some of our new members found they could not make the time needed to provide a meaningful contribution and for perfectly valid reasons had to withdraw*. All committee meetings were conducted using the now very familiar Zoom meeting app which proved highly successful even with meetings of up to 50.

With our season start in much doubt, we commenced the integration of another 34 teams into our fixture and with the 10 from the previous season it meant our senior competition had expanded by over 37% in just two seasons to 161 teams. We prepared grades that provided for the inclusion of a new team into Newey and four new teams into Pascoe Shield. To smooth the transition for all we included 10 teams into Meehan and maintained 3 smaller grades for Yarra Valley only.

As part of the integration of the clubs from the former Yarra Valley Cricket Association, a formal Transition Committee was formed and met about bi-monthly. The committee was chaired by Pat Meehan and included RDCA Senior and Junior Secretaries, RDCA Finance Manager and former YVCA President, David Peel and Vice President, Paul Broussard. This

proved to be a very effective committee enabling the transition both administratively and on-field with very little fuss. The committee continues to meet to tidy up the final financial and legal requirements. A post-season review with Yarra Valley clubs clearly indicated they were very pleased with the transition and most are looking forward to becoming integrated into the RDCA District and Modified Divisions.

Approval to commence training finally came through in mid-October and clubs were permitted strictly controlled training sessions for three weeks before our season that would start on the 14th November 2020. This start date enabled us to fit 14 H&A rounds of all one-dayers plus finals. To simplify our grading structure we made some minor, but important changes. We introduced 3 Divisions for the main RDCA grades and one for Yarra Valley. Premier Division was expanded to include Spencer Shield and only contains 1st and 2nd XI teams. Grades A to E were grouped as District Division and our Modified format was renamed grades M1 to M6 in Modified Division. The Yarra Valley Division comprised 3 grades, Strachan, Finger and Hammond.

Our season experienced relatively good weather with no rounds being washed out. COVID-19 reared its head again in mid-February 2021 when the government enforced a one-week lockdown which automatically cancelled round 12. We moved into finals in March and this season because we had all one-day finals, we were able to make each of the Sundays a reserve day. This proved to be quite significant because Saturday the 13th March 2021 was quite wet and it was also Grand Final day for all our lower grades. The RDCA Senior Weather Committee decided early that morning to reschedule all games to the Sunday. This proved to be the correct decision as the Sunday provided an excellent forum for all finals to play to their full conclusion.

Over the years this report has continually noted the strong and effective communications required between club secretaries and our Association administrators to make everything work well. Never more so was this required than season 2020/21 with the combination of the COVID-19 pandemic and the quite strict plans and operations and the integration of the YVCA clubs. Thank you to all club secretaries, especially our new brethren from the Yarra Valley as they embraced all the changes and were very responsive in getting things done. A huge team effort that delivered 2,177 senior games of cricket with a minimum of fuss.

Some interesting statistics:

Individual players who played at least one game of Senior cricket – 2,751

Least number of players played in one grade – Trollope with 130

Most number of players played in one grade – M4 with 283

Average number of players used per grade increases for every grade from Trollope to E Grade (with the exception of B Grade which used the most players)

The 2 Trollope Grand Finalists used the least number of players for any teams – 14, as did 2 other Grand Finalists, Norwood in Wilkins and Heathwood in Meehan.

Thanks to Ian Spencer and Pat Meehan for liaising and meeting with council officers as required during the season and to Ian Spencer for again very competently organising all scorebook and cricket ball supplies.

Ground shortages for Saturday cricket remain an issue in most council areas and all councils we work with managed to supply replacement grounds or extra grounds where required to avoid playing on Sundays. Silcock North and South (Croydon Ranges) was being redeveloped, so was unplayable for the entire season, replaced by Griff Hunt. Wandin Reserve (Wandin) was out of action, replaced with Silvan Rec Reserve. Templeton was supposed to have its 2 main grounds (Templeton and Milperra) back by the end of November but they weren't available until Feb-21. Warrandyte and Wonga Park with high team numbers continued to stretch Manningham Council for extra grounds, but all were able to be accommodated.

We still managed to run our T20 competition, with 5 round robin rounds squeezed in before Christmas and the finals in late January. Congratulations to the Grand Finalists – Ainslie Park and South Croydon (Trollope), played at Ainslie Park and Bayswater Park and South Warrandyte (Wilkins) played at Guy Turner Reserve. T20 Grand Finals were played on the evening of Monday 25th January with the winners being Ainslie Park and South Warrandyte. Montrose CC is to be congratulated for the excellent feat of getting all 6 of their senior teams into the finals. Four teams made it to their Grand Finals and two achieved premierships and one got pipped on the very last ball. A great all-round club effort that made Montrose CC a runaway winner of the Phil McCallum Senior Club Championship. Congratulations to Wantirna South CC who won the Bob Bissett Best Administered Club award, and Healesville 2nd XI, the Bob Ellis Spirit of Cricket award.

Congratulations to all grade premiers – 16 different clubs out of 37 across 20 grades were premiership winners. Multiple winners were Montrose, Norwood, South Warrandyte and Wonga Park all with 2 premierships each.

To all the individual trophy winners, well done and whilst they are individual awards, clubs will be proud of their members' achievement. Notably, two of our medalists are back-to-back winners, Ryan Smith (South Croydon) and Trent Sier (Ainslie Park).

Umpires Association - Tony Gawne

It’s fair to say season 2020/2021 was very different from any other season from the outset, mainly due to the implications of the COVID pandemic. At one stage there was serious

thought about whether the season would start or not. Fortunately it did albeit in a shortened version with all games including finals being played as one day fixtures.

On behalf of the Executive I would like to acknowledge the support of our members throughout the year and especially welcome those who joined us for the first time. The merger with the Yarra Valley Cricket Association resulted in an additional 8 umpires joining our ranks so at one stage our active list grew to 53 to start the season. We lost a few on the way for various reasons but the pleasing part was that 12 new umpires joined the ranks through the season and all adjusted well and impressed in their inaugural season. At times unavailability stretched our resources and commitment and despite our desire to have 2 umpires standing in each Premier Grade, realistically with the introduction of the Ian Spencer grade and servicing Strachan Shield in Yarra Hub, it was always going to be difficult. The feedback through our Captains' Reports on Umpires' Performance indicates members are generally exceeding expectations. However Club leaders need to be aware these reports are well used by the Executive and Selectors to monitor the individual performance of the umpires so rather than just giving number ratings specific comments to justify their assessment is vital in evaluating their overall performance.

On behalf of the RDCAUA Executive group I acknowledge the support and guidance provided by Chairman Paul Denton in the management of the RDCA Umpires' Association. It was a hard act to follow the long-serving Steve Pascoe but his extensive past experience on the Executive assisted him with almost a seamless transition.

Solid support was provided by Jordon Russell (Assistant Secretary & Social), Andy Laws (Chairman of Selectors), Shawn Everitt (Recruitment), Barry Johnson (Property), Steve Pascoe (Umpires' Mentor), Warren Gilbert (Observer/Training) and Graeme Lloyd (Umpires' Advisor / Training) continued the strong leadership and development of panel members all committed to the goal of raising umpiring standards. This season Doug Coldham joined the group in an ex-officio role to consider taking on a future Executive role.

Due to the ongoing restrictions on public gatherings the greater majority of our meetings this season were conducted via Zoom which kept our members well informed on the RDCA day-to-day issues and COVID updates. Member attendance improved significantly as a result and the thinking going forward is to conduct the early meetings face-to-face for induction and training purposes but where circumstances permit to revert to Zoom meetings. During the year the Executive and panel members chalked up many achievements, some of which are recognized here:

- Life Membership to RDCAUA was bestowed on Graeme Lloyd, who has been the Umpires Advisor and Training Officer since 2001/2002. Graeme continues to play an important role in keeping performance levels to the expected standard. His sessions are always thought provoking and well prepared.
- Congratulations to Eddie Wu & Shawn Everitt on their appointment to umpire the Trollope Grand Final, a just reward for Ed (who missed it last year because of lockdown) and the first for Shawn. IT topped off a great season for Shawn as he was received the Ken Dunham Award as "Umpire of the Year".
- Accreditation for Community Officiating (Level 1) and Working with Children is now a minimum requirement for all umpires. The process for both can now be completed on-line so it's a relatively easy process for new members and those seeking

reaccreditation. We continue to work towards all umpires completing and updating their status.

- RDCA Umpiring milestones awards were presented to Martien Pruyzers who passed the 600 game milestone (now 613), Paul Denton the 500 game milestone (now 514), Marty Clohesy 400 (418), Leigh Murray (308), Barry Johnson (227), Noel Gilbert (205) and it's worth mentioning Lothar Pilz ending the season on 465 games.
- RDCAUA met all its umpiring commitments by providing umpires for all inter-Association matches, VMCU Junior Carnival, T20 fixtures and Veterans' Finals series. Thank you to all those members for their ongoing support.
- This season, and once again due to the COVID situation, the method of umpire payments changed and with the agreement of members payments were made electronically on a monthly basis. The new payment system was well received by the group and going forward will be maintained. I personally would like to thank Lothar Pilz & Graeme Seymour for their ongoing assistance in setting up a reliable payment system. Lothar's work in developing a workable template was outstanding and justified the many hours he spent in matching appointments to the fixtures in the MyCricket database.
- An end-of-season BBQ was arranged by Jordan Russell which was financially supported by the RDCA BoM and Senior Committee. A terrific evening was had by those attending (28) and our appreciation is extended to Sam Barnes & Wantirna South CC for hosting this event.

We now prepare for season 2021/2022 and the newly elected Executive Group have already turned their attention to preparations for next season. Doug Coldham is the newly elected Chairman and will be ably supported by Jordan Russell who has stepped up from Assistant Secretary to take on the Secretary role. It all starts again, the tweaking of rules, recruitment promotion, training – it doesn't really stop. If you know of anyone in your club or through your networks who may be interested in taking up umpiring please pass on details to Shawn Everitt who will touch base and provide all the necessary information to get them started. The best time to make these referrals is during the off season which allows new members sufficient time to complete the accreditation process. Our focus is to continue to expand our panel numbers and the progression from playing cricket to umpiring is the best option to recruit those who with a cricket background.

Thank you to all who contributed to the success of last season and, we trust, that support will continue in the future.

JUNIOR COMPETITION REPORT

Despite all the challenges thrown at us we were able to run a tremendous season of Junior cricket. With a November start, we made the decision to make it a season of one day games and introduced a batting ball count in all divisions. This was done to ensure all players were given the opportunity to bat and bowl in most games and it was the best decision we made. Other competitions found it difficult to engage all players in short form cricket but our structure ensured this happened.

We welcomed the Yarra Valley Cricket Association into the RDCA and it was a great success. We were able to blend their sides into our existing divisions and it provided us greater flexibility with grading. It was great to see the Yarra Valley clubs getting challenged and playing exciting games of cricket each weekend.

The RDCA girls competition continues to grow and we increased from 23 to 31 teams. We also expanded the competition to have under 12, 14 & 16 age groups although new players are able to enter in at their appropriate skill level. This was the first time we had enough playing numbers to run a stage 3 competition and Mt Evelyn won an enthralling game against Templeton to collect the Mandy Dolman Division.

Overall there were 27 divisions of cricket playing for premierships and we had 21 different clubs win premierships. This is a fantastic result and shows how competitive our competition is. North Ringwood won the club championship and 4 premierships. Congratulations to all the Bulls who helped their club win this award for the 3rd year in a row.

We are very lucky to have a hard working and enthusiastic junior committee who ensure we run a professional competition. Bill Stafford stepped in as secretary taking over from Mandy Dolman. Bill fulfills so many important roles in the RDCA and it was fitting that we named the Club Champion award after him. Bill does all our fixturing and ground allocation early in the season. From there he focuses on the Representative Program and assembles coaches. Then it is trials and the January carnival. Once this is finished it is onto the RDCA finals and then a rest so he can watch the Cats in the AFL.

Doug Dowling took from Andy Exley in allocating umpires and was a welcome addition to the junior committee. He was joined by Cam Darwall and Leah Parker who joined our committee from the YVCA. It was great to have representation from the Valley and they both helped us gain a greater understanding of the needs of our new clubs.

Jas Harrison continued to oversee the outstanding girls program. Growing to 31 teams has exceeded our own expectations and Jas has been a key person in this space over the last 5 seasons. We expect further growth in this space and Jas should be applauded for her efforts to grow the competition and we look forward to these players moving into any number of senior teams over the coming seasons.

The strength of the junior committee is having quality people from a range of junior clubs assisting and making good decisions. We thank Luke Henderson from South Croydon, Sean

Meehan from Templeton and Steve Toohey from Warranwood who all provide wisdom, patience and their own vast array of experience to help the committee and our clubs.

The continued support of our major sponsor, Saxon Sports is invaluable. The ongoing support from Paul Attfield and Scott Brasher is much appreciated. Having access to their great indoor facility and the coaching they provide is so important for our young players. The rule changes we have implemented over the last few years have been met with widespread approval. They have improved the enjoyment our young players derive from the game. We thank the clubs for their ongoing support.

Junior Secretary - Bill Stafford

COVID 19 which caused disruption to the end of last season was still with us. In September when clubs were trying to organise teams, Victoria were in the middle of a second wave of COVID and the government enforced a lock down in Metropolitan Melbourne. Eventually COVID was brought under control and Cricket Victoria in consultation with the state government developed a number of COVID protocols that would allow cricket to commence in November.

Our season started on 13th November and with only 14 weekends available a decision was made to play all one-day games including finals. Clubs quickly adopted to the COVID protocols and we were able to get the season completed. There was a minor setback in February when there was a minor out break of COVID and government enforced a 5 day lock down which resulted in round 11 being abandon.

The clubs are to be commended in these trying times in being able to organise teams, which was very difficult as any form of training was not allowed until early November.

Yarra Valley Cricket Association merged with the RDCA increasing our junior teams by 25. To minimise travel we introduced Yarra Valley grades for U/14s, U/12s and Mini Bash. Some of the high performing team within Yarra Valley were happy to integrate into RDCA grades. Overall, the merger from a junior perspective went very smoothly.

As recognition of the significant contribution made within the Yarra Valley Cricket Association juniors by Di Day and Keith Thompson, the following awards/grades have been named after them:

- Di Day Best Female Player
- U/12-5 Keith Thompson Shield

RDCA junior competition continues to grow even taking into account the Yarra Valley merger, grades increased from 24 to 33 and teams from 203 to 250.

This season we introduced stages (3) to the girl's competition, moving away from the traditional age groups. This allows girls to play in a team based on their ability and not their age. This season we had 5 grades and 31 teams, as compared to 3 and 23 respectively the previous season. The standard also continues to improve. This was very evident with our U/16 VMCU team winning our first girls' premiership.

We kicked off the season with Barefoot Indigenous round. At the end of each game, players formed a barefoot circle and a player read a statement about acknowledgement to country. We joined forces with Saxon Sports and with Mukti Australia (a Christian organisation for disadvantage woman and children) in sending cricket gear to Sri Lanka. Clubs and families supported us in dropping off second hand junior cricket equipment and clothing to Saxon Sports. Over 100kg of equipment was shipped over to Sri Lanka.

Vale Don Smith

Don first played competitive cricket at the age of 14 in the senior competition in his hometown of Wangaratta.

After a period of not playing cricket, Don joined St. Andrews Cricket Club and it was a 'home' for Don for many years with Don providing significant service to the club, both on and off the playing field. Don joined the club when it was formed in the 1964/65 season and, off the field, has filled many roles including being Treasurer from 1975/76 to 1982/83 and President from 1985/86 to 1988/89. On the field, Don had what can only be described as an imposing playing record. He played 296 games for St. Andrews across most grades and made 5,865 runs and took 785 wickets - a record he can be justly proud of.

Amongst his personal milestones, Don won 5 First Eleven batting and 4 bowling awards at club level and other averages in the lower grades. Association batting and bowling awards, - B Grade (1965/66) and Chandler Shield (1971/72) batting awards and 'D' grade (1964/65), Chandler Shield (1976/77), 'E' grade (1988/89) and Chandler 4 (1991/92) bowling averages enhance a career that included RDCA representative matches as both a player and umpire. Don's playing career was spread over a lengthy period - from 1964/65 to retirement after the 1993/94 season.

For many years Don played alongside his close friend John Macmillan, who was also a club and RDCA Life Member (John passed away peacefully in April 2021, a few weeks after Don's passing). Don was acknowledged for his dedicated service to St. Andrews Cricket Club with Life Membership in 1977/78. The club has further acknowledged Don by naming its Club Championship Award after him.

Don's service to cricket, like most of our RDCA Life Members, went beyond club loyalties. He had been involved as one of the original organisers of the RDCA Veterans Competition in the late 1980s and served for many years on the RDCA Umpires Association where he held the positions of President and Vice President. A long umpiring career followed on immediately from his playing days and Don was seen each Saturday for many years 'doing the rounds' as he kept an eye on the umpiring fraternity, particularly the newer members. Service on the Executive spanned many years and included the important Social Secretary role.

Don's contribution to the Association was formally acknowledged in 1986/87 when he was appropriately awarded Life Membership - a fine reward for service over many years.

Life Membership of the RDCA Umpires Association followed in 2011/12 and Don has a senior competition grade named in his honour.

In March 2021 Don was an inaugural inductee into the RDCA Hall of Fame, an honour he was aware of and was presented with, shortly before he passed away later that month.

The following words about Don were included in the RDCA Centenary and Hall of Fame program for the dinner held on 26th March 2021.

"Don was an inaugural member of St. Andrews C.C. in 1964-65 and has enjoyed a long playing, administrative and umpiring involvement at club and Association level. A successful playing career of 30 years led to an involvement in the establishment of the Veterans competition as well as a lengthy umpiring career that included being President of the Umpire's Association. Don has a senior Association grade competition named after him and is an Association, Umpire's Association and club Life Member. He has the Club Championship Award carrying his name at St. Andrews."

Vale Phil Mcallum

Phil McCallum was born in Hamilton, Victoria and was educated to Matriculation (year 12) level at Hamilton High School. He later enlisted in the Air Force for war service as a signals/ teleprinter operator in New Guinea and Borneo.

Phil was involved in many organisations for many years as a dedicated volunteer and contributor to community activities and in 1993, he was awarded the prestigious Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) in recognition of his services to the Community.

Sport always played a part in Phil's activities. His cricket career began at Camberwell Methodists C.C. before he moved to East Ringwood United Churches C.C. This club merged with Croydon West C.C. with the new club known as Ainslie Park Cricket Club. Phil was the Foundation President of the new club and he 'plied his trade' as an opening batsman and wicket-keeper whilst he guided the club in consolidating its position in the Association.

Phil found time to become involved with the Association's Executive where he served for many years. The 1983/84 Annual Report mentions that he was retiring from the Executive after 16 years of service. During that period, Phil variously served as Chairman of the Pinks Reserve Turf Wicket Committee, Manager of the Kilsyth Indoor Cricket Centre, Tribunal member, Records and Results Secretary and as the delegate for 4 years to the Cricket Union of Victoria (CUOV). Such was his impact there Phil served as Chairman of the CUOV Executive for 3 years. Phil McCallum was awarded Life Membership of the Association in 1976/77 and as further recognition of his service to the Association the Senior Club Championship Trophy is named the "Phil McCallum Club Championship Award".

Phil was also the author of the book "from Paddocks to Parks", which is "A History of the Development of Cricket in the Lilydale, Croydon, Ringwood and Ferntree Gully Districts and of the Ringwood and District Cricket Association". This magnificent publication has provided significant information in compiling these Life Member 'summaries' and can be found on the RDCA website.

Vale John Macmillan

John was a solicitor who was born in Melbourne. After being a senior partner in a large legal firm he then practiced law on a consultancy basis and acted as the Association's Legal Advisor for many years.

John played cricket for Canterbury Presbyterians for 16 years playing representative cricket at the Under 21 level. He moved to St. Andrews Cricket Club in the 1964/65 season where he became a Foundation Member of the club following a name change from Heathmont Presbyterians. He was the first Captain/Coach of the new club and served in that capacity from 1964/65 to 1967/68. In that time the club won premierships in B grade in 1965/66 and then A Grade in 1966/67 and these achievements in successive seasons led the club into the Chandler Shield grade.

At St. Andrews, John played 160 games across all Grades during the period from 1964/65 to 1980/81. He accumulated 2,664 runs at an average of 20.34 and took 90 wickets at an average of 18.01. He was the First Eleven Captain for 4 years, President of the club for 3 years from 1970/71 to 1972/73 and was awarded the club's second Life Membership accolade in 1971/72. In a playing career of 32 years, John played for 20 years in the top grade and played in five senior Premiership teams - three in the RDCA and two in the Eastern Suburban Churches competition. He captained 2 of these premiership teams.

John offered distinguished service to the Association for many years, dating from the early 1970s when the then Association President, Bill Dean, asked him to revise the Association's Constitution and Rules. John spent over 15 years on the Association Executive and served as a Vice President in 1975/76 and 1976/77. After that service, he acted for over 15 years (until 2006/07) as Chairman of the Association's Tribunal / Investigation Committee and then took on the role of Chairman of the Appeals Tribunal.

John was awarded Life Membership of the Association in 2000/01, an award richly deserved in recognising his contribution to the competition. Throughout his association with St. Andrews and the competition, John remained firm friends with Don Smith, a teammate and fellow St. Andrews and RDCA Life Member. John maintained a strong interest in both St. Andrews Cricket Club and the Association.

Since the 2010/11 season, John has had a senior competition grade named in his honour.

John sadly passed away in April 2021.
